

MUSEUM VENUES for corporate events





The museum offers its Corporate Members a variety of spaces for holding business meetings, presentations, social gatherings, and all kinds of corporate events.

The **Atrium** is the true heart of the museum and a central feature of Frank O. Gehry's architectural design. With a ceiling height of 55 m and a floor area of approximately 900 m², the Atrium opens onto all of the galleries and the terrace. The Atrium is an extraordinary venue for hosting formal dinners, with a maximum seating capacity of 400; cocktail parties for as many as 800 guests; and any other type of gathering, such as awards ceremonies, business presentations, etc. It is available for use when the museum is closed to the public.

The **Hall** has a floor area of 330 m² and standing room for up to 300 people. Its location between the Auditorium and the Atrium makes it the perfect place for social gatherings before, during, or after an event in the Auditorium, or simply for serving cocktails to a smaller group of guests. Available for use when the museum is closed to the public.

The **Auditorium** is the most suitable place for meetings, press conferences, and cultural events. It can hold up to 300 people and has a separate entrance from exhibition space. The Auditorium is equipped with all necessary audiovisual technology for computer, video, and film presentations. Available for use at any time and on any day.

The multipurpose **Education Space** has two levels and can simultaneously accommodate meetings for up to 40 people and cocktail parties for a maximum of 80 guests. Available except when reserved for school workshops.

The **Library** is a warm, inviting space with furnishings designed by Frank Gehry. It can accommodate meetings for groups of 30 people or less. The Library is available for use at any time and on any day.
